

## What Happens When There's an Alarm?

### 1. Activation

The CCTV systems records 24 hours a day and the site is provided with an on site monitor for your own viewing.



The PIR heat and motion sensors detect activation and send footage to the Control Room.



### 2. Monitoring

The Control Room Operatives answer each alarm and decide what action to take. All footage is held on the server for 90 days.



When an alarm is received the activation footage is shown alongside the live view with site instructions.



### 3. Response

Once an intruder is verified, a live audio warning is given by the Control Room Operative and the Police are called.



The Police are given the site address, details of incident, intruders' description and instructions around the site.



### 4. Reporting

Along with every incident, our Mobile Supervisor also attends site to ensure site safety and to check for any broken boundaries.



The Mobile Supervisor then compiles a full Incident Report to be sent to the Site Manager or instructed persons.
